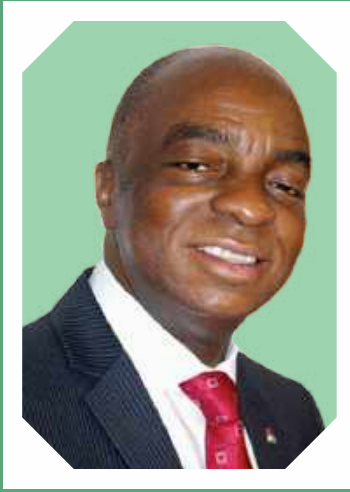

POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMS AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

DOCTORAL (PHD) DEGREE

Admissions into any of the Doctoral programmes are available to any graduate of Landmark University, or graduate of any other University recognized by the Landmark University Senate/ National University Commission (NUC), who possesses a Master's degree relevant to the intended programme.

However, such intending candidate should have scored:

- i. An average of at least 60% **OR** minimum 3.5 CGPA (on a scale of 5.0) in his/her Master's degree programme.
- ii. Between 55% - 59% to qualify for M.Phil/PhD.

Course Duration:

Duration for a PhD degree programme is a minimum period of six (6) semesters and a maximum period of ten (10) semesters for full-time candidates.

Relevant Courses are to be taken for the PhD studies, a Thesis and publications* in Landmark University acceptable outlets are required for graduation at the end of the PhD programme.

NOTE: An M.Phil./PhD candidate will only proceed on a PhD programme having scored a minimum weighted average of 60%. Otherwise, the candidate repeats M.Phil/PhD or withdraws.

MASTER'S DEGREE

Admissions into any of the Master's Degree programmes are available to any graduate of Landmark University and any other University recognized by the Landmark University Senate/(NUC), who possesses the following requirements.

At least a minimum of:

- (i) Second Class Lower Honours Degree in relevant discipline.
- (ii) Third-Class Bachelor's degree/ HND and a minimum of upper credit pass in PGD. Candidate must also possess cognate industrial experience for admissions into a Master's programme.

Course Duration:

Duration for a Master's degree programme is a minimum period of three (3) semesters and a maximum period of six (6) semesters for full-time candidates. Relevant Courses will be taken for the Master Degree studies. A Dissertation and publications* in Landmark University acceptable outlets are required for graduation at the end of the programme.

DIPLOMA (PGD)

Admissions into any of the Postgraduate Diploma programmes are available to any graduate of Landmark University, or any other Tertiary Institution recognized by the Landmark University Senate/(NUC), who possesses the following requirements.

- (i) Five (5) credit passes including English, Mathematics and three other relevant subjects at 'O' levels
- (ii) Candidates with Bachelor's degree from an approved University must obtain a minimum of Third Class in relevant discipline.
- (iii) Holders of HND in relevant programmes from approved institutions with a minimum of Lower Credit pass.

Course Duration:

Duration for a Postgraduate Diploma Programme is a minimum period of two (2) semesters and a maximum period of four (4) semesters for

full-time candidates. A part-time candidate will, however, spend a minimum period of four (4) semesters and a maximum period of six (6) Semesters. However, for Engineering programmes, a minimum of four (4) semesters and maximum of six (6) semesters for full time and a minimum of six (6) semesters and eight (8) semesters for part-time.

A Dissertation and publications* in Landmark University acceptable outlets are required for graduation at the end of the programme.

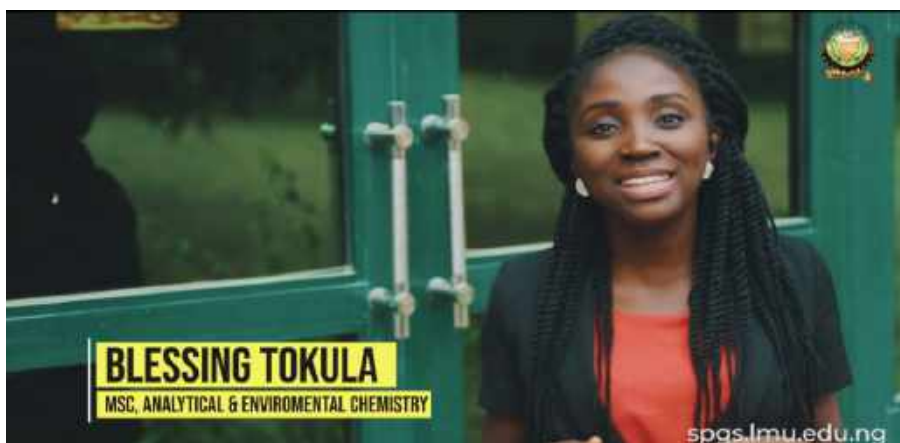
